Basil Genovese

Ocimum Basilicum Genovese

A **P** **Z** **1** 24"

- most familiar basil
- spicy cinnamon clove scent
- tall with dark green leaves, slow to bolt



Basil Thai

Ocimum Basilicum 'Thai'

A **P** **Z** **1** 24-36"

- mild licorice flavour and fragrance
- great in Thai cooking
- dark green leaves with purple flowers



Chives

Allium Schoenoprasum

P **C** **Z** **1** **2** **3-9** **1** 24"

- member of the onion family
- pale purple to pink clover like flowers
- large clumping with long hollow leaves



Cilantro (Coriander)

Coriandrum Sativum

A **P** **Z** **1** 24"

- also known as Chinese parsley
- slowest to bolt with excellent flavour
- high essential oil content



Dill

Anethum Graveolens

A **Z** **1** 30"

- best known for making dill pickles
- feathery foliage with yellow flowers
- use fresh or harvest seeds



Mint Spearmint

Mentha Spicata

P **C** **Z** **1** **2** **3-9** **1** 15"

- sweet scented with green wrinkled leaves
- the best mint for cooking



Oregano

Origanum Vulgare

P **C** **Z** **1** 5-9" **1** 14"

- an important herb in Italian, Greek and Mexican cooking



Parsley Curled

Petroselinum Crispum

A **P** **Z** **1** **2** **3-9** **1** 8-12"

- use fresh to garnish
- add flavour to almost any dish



Parsley Italian

Petroselinum Crispum Neapolitanum

A **P** **Z** **1** **2** **3-9** **1** 12"

- same uses as curled parsley but with a stronger flavour and harder



Rosemary

Rosmarinus Officinalis

- great flavour and aroma
- evergreen shrub with blunt, needle-like leaves



Sage Salvia

Salvia Officinalis

- most common culinary variety
- staple ingredient for poultry stuffing
- a potent condiment for meat

Basil African Blue

Ocimum Kilimandscharicum x Basilicum

11 36-48"

- large plant with sweet spicy scent
- purple/green leaves with veining
- hybrid between dark opal and camphor basil



Basil Genovese (Lettuce Leaf)

Ocimum Basilicum Genovese

19-24"

- most familiar basil, slow to bolt
- spicy cinnamon clove scent
- tall, with large dark green leaves
- also available in 6" x 6"



Basil Lemon

Ocimum Basilicum Citriodorum

15-24"

- small pointed leaves
- intense fragrance of lemon, best in tea
- potpourri friendly



Basil Red Ball ***PPAF

Ocimum Basilicum Herbace (Red Ball)

5"

- compact basil with small red-purple leaves
- great in small pots
- bright pink edible flowers in the late summer
- use flowers to add flavour to your salad
- beautiful as an edimental in your garden



Basil Thai

Ocimum Basilicum Thai

24-36"

- mild licorice flavour and fragrance
- great in Thai cooking
- dark green, small leaves with purple stems



Chamomile German

Matricaria Recutita

12-24"

- feathery foliage with white daisy like flowers
- tea made from flowers aids digestion



Basil Aristotle

Ocimum Basilicum Aristotle

12-24"

- small leaves, highly aromatic
- good tolerance to poor weather makes for excellent garden performance



Basil Holy (Tulsi)

Ocimum Sanctum

24-36"

- commonly used in Hindu culture
- great in Thai cuisine and in tea
- helps digestive system



Basil Mammoth

Ocimum Basilicum mammoth

18-24"

- used in Italian dishes
- vibrant, large "mammoth" sized leaves
- garden filler



Basil Rosie

Ocimum Basilicum Rosie

12-16"

- purple bronze coloured foliage
- used in Italian dishes
- great as an accent plant in planters



Basil Wild Magic ***PPAF

Ocimum Basilicum Herbace (Wild Magic)

16"

- robust dark green shrub, full leaves, with reddish leaf colouring, sweet edible pink flowers
- use flowers to add flavour to your salad
- beautiful as an edimental in your garden



Chervil (French Parsley)

Anthriscus Carotifolium

18-24"

- aromatic anise flavour
- bright green divided leaves, similar to parsley



Basil Columnar

Ocimum Basilicum greek columnar

24-36"

- upright column basil with glossy green leaves
- same as sweet basil
- try in salads, pastos, breads etc



Basil Italian Large Leaf

Ocimum Basilicum

24-30"

- large plant
- medium-dark green leaves
- scent and taste are sweeter than Genovese



Basil Perpetual Pesto™ **PPAF

*Ocimum x Citriodorum™ **PPAF*

24-48"

- variegated with white and light green colour
- grows columnar
- similar to sweet basil in fragrance and flavour



Basil Small Leaf

Ocimum Basilicum minimum

4-12"

- globular bush basil with a nice spicy flavour
- planted next to tomatoes, adds to flavour



Catnip

Nepeta Cataria

3-9 24-48"

- cat attracting perennial
- gray-green leaves, white flowers
- used in cat toys/treats, herbal teas
- attracts bees



Chives

Allium Schoenoprasum

3-9 8-12"

- member of the onion family
- pale purple to pink clover like flowers
- large clumping with long hollow leaves
- also available in 6" x 6"

**Chives Garlic***Allium Tuberosum*

P P P P P P P P P P 3-9 18-24"

- flat leaves with white clover like flowers
- combination of garlic and chives
- great source of vitamins A and C

**Curry Plant***Helichrysum italicum*

P P P P P P P P P P 8-9 18-24"

- silver foliage with yellow blooms (July-Sept.)
- upright, compact habit

**Fennel***Foeniculum Vulgare*

A P P P P P P P P P 18"

- feathery foliage with a sweet licorice flavour
- fennel mulch keeps snails and slugs out of your garden

**Hops Sterling***Humulus lupulus 'Sterling'***NEW**

- spicy, citrus aroma, herbal notes
- resistant to downy mildew and powdery mildew
- very high tannins and very low carophyllene
- delicately spiced, citrusy aroma with both a floral and herbal punch

CANNOT EXPORT TO U.S.****Lavender GrossoLavandula x Intermedia Grosso*

P P P P P P P P P P 5-9 24-36"

- aromatic, silver foliage, violet-blue coloured flower
- blooms in late spring and throughout summer

**Lavender Provence***Lavandula x Intermedia Provence*

P P P P P P P P P P 5-9 24-36"

- silvery leaves on tightly branched plants
- light lavender-blue spikes, blooms early May

**Lemon Grass***Cymbopogon Flexuosus*

P P P P P P P P P P 9-13 24-36"

- forms a dense clump of tapering leaves
- leaves have lemon flavour and fragrance

**Cilantro (Coriander)***Coriandrum Sativum*

A P P P P P P P P P 18-24"

- also known as Chinese parsley
- slowest to bolt with excellent flavour
- high content of essential oils
- aromatic seeds have an orange scent
- **also available in 6" x 6"**

**Dill***Anethum Graveolens*

A P P P P P P P P P 18-24"

- best known for making dill pickles
- feathery foliage with yellow flowers (June-Aug.)
- use fresh or harvest seeds

**Garlic***Allium Sativum*

P P P P P P P P P P 3-8 18-24"

- crushed cloves are indispensable in any type of cuisine
- infuses entrees, soups and salads with sweet, mild flavor

**Lavender English (Munstead)***Lavandula Angustifolia 'munstead'*

P P P P P P P P P P 4-8 12-18"

- aromatic grey green leaves
- tall spikes of purple flowers with a sweet fragrance
- **also available in 6" x 6"**

**Lavender Jagged***Lavandula Pinnate var 'bucht'*

P P P P P P P P P P 9-11 24"

- fast growing with finely divided leaves
- great in planters, great bloomer
- use for borders in your garden

**Lavender Ruffles Boysenberry *PPAF***Lavandula Hybrid *PPAF*

P P P P P P P P P P 8-9 18-24"

- early flowering
- beautiful large ruffled flowers
- drought tolerant variety

**Lovage***Levisticum Officinale*

P P P P P P P P P P 4-8 3-5"

- tastes very much like celery
- tall with glossy divided leaves
- roots and young stems are edible
- yellow flowers appear in late spring

**Coriander Vietnamese***Polygonum Odoratum*

P P P P P P P P P P 11+ 12-16"

- low growing spreading plant
- tender stems and small light green leaves

**Echinacea***Echinacea Purpurea*

P P P P P P P P P P 3-10 24"

- daisy like flowers with a raised cone shape
- known for its medicinal uses

**Hops Perle***Humulus lupulus 'Perle'*

- bittering & Aroma
- resistant to verticillium wilt and downy mildew
- a pleasant aroma, elements of mint and pine with a hint of spice
- a good substitute for Hallertau Mittelfrüh

NEW**Lavender Hidcote Blue***Lavandula Angustifolia*

P P P P P P P P P P 12-24" 5-9"

- erect, compact growth habit
- blue-green foliage
- dark blue-purple flowers
- sweet fragrance

**Lavender Kew Red***Lavandula Stoechas 'kew red'*

P P P P P P P P P P 8-10 18-24"

- outstanding pink and burgundy flowers on fragrant grey green plants
- a garden favourite
- butterflies love this variety

**Lemon Balm***Melissa Officinatis*

P P P P P P P P P P 5 18-24"

- lemon scented herb is excellent for making teas and food drinks
- rub leaf on wood furniture for an amazing fragrance

**Marjoram***Origanum Majorana*

P P P P P P P P P P 3-11 12-24"

- tastes similar to Oregano
- small oval green leaves
- flowers are edible
